



Forum rules iBOOD

In the last few years iBOOD had gathered a loyal group of followers and a lot of people in different countries are discussing the daily deal on the iBOOD Forum. You can imagine that it's necessary to create some rules and guidelines. A couple of rules may sound childish but we want to make sure that the forum has an open and pleasant atmosphere so that everyone feels free to leave his or her opinion.

Of course we expect that all visitors use their own common sense and that everyone will show respect to other visitors and the moderators. So please play the game with the following rules and guidelines in mind.

General rules and guidelines

- The iBOOD product forum is only accessible for iBOOD members. In the product topics you can share information concerning the deal of the day and of course you can also leave your opinion. Just make sure you explain on which facts you base your opinion.

- To make sure there is a quality discussion on the product forum, comments like 'First post', 'Stupid', or 'Already have one' and that kind of useless comments, will be deleted by the moderating team.

- All comments should be 'on topic'.

- Off topic questions or complaints will be immediately forwarded to our customer service and will be deleted from the forum. In case you have complaints or questions, please contact our customer service, who is ready to help you, by using the contact form on the website.

- Make sure you don't make too many typos or big spelling errors, though a mistake can always happen of course.

- Show respect for other visitors and moderators.

- Price comparisons are always welcome, but please make sure you are comparing identical products. Price comparisons should always be supported with a link to the website you are referring to.

- Comments which claim that the product is cheaper elsewhere without correct proof will be deleted by the moderating team.



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- iBOOD has the right to delete every link to competing companies. So please don't promote your own website on our forum.

Not allowed on the iBOOD forum

Verbal violence

Be nice to each other. We don't allow the use of bad words or anyone who is deliberately hurting other members or moderators.

Violence

Violence in pictures, links or movies are not welcome and will be deleted.

Pornography

All forms of pornography are forbidden on iBOOD. There are plenty of other websites that you can visit for that.

Promotion

It's not allowed to promote the following:

1. Services
2. Websites including sitechecks
3. Events
4. Referrals in URLs
5. All other spam

Personal data

Please don't leave Telephone numbers or address data on our forum.

Crime

Not only the actual crime, but also planning, promoting or suggesting crime is strictly forbidden and all comments will be deleted.

Accounts

Using more than one account on the forum is forbidden.

Unnecessary use of CAPITALS!

- Unnecessary use of CAPITALS or bold lines is not allowed. (An exception on this rule is the moderation team of iBOOD).



Moderation team

- A moderator has the right to delete a comment when it's not in line with the rules and guidelines as described above.
- A moderator has the right to ban users when his or her comments are not in line with the rules and guidelines as described above.
- Do you see something that is absolutely not ok, then you can always report this by mailing it to forum[at]ihood [dot]com.

Banning

What can you expect if you don't follow the forum rules and guidelines?

- Comments can be deleted or partially deleted by the moderating team.
- Comments that are not in line with the rules and guidelines will be deleted.
- If you keep posting comments that are not in line with the rules then the moderators can ban you from the forum.

When will members be banned?

- Posting several comments that ruin the atmosphere on the forum and are not in line with the rules and guidelines.
- Ignoring several warnings from the moderating team.
- Creating a new account while you are banned.

Can I get unbanned?
